PROJECT RESULTS

We launched our online platform, the **e-Learning Campus**, created as a set of interactive online resources aimed at teachers, community, and adult educators as an ICT-based pedagogical tool to support numeracy education.

This project output enables Adult and community educators to:

- Attend an online course based on a new digital pedagogy, curriculum on entrepreneurship in intercultural and interfaith contexts.
- Design and create customized modules to support the training process of adult learners.
